Advanced Endoscopic Procedures

Guthrie offers specialized endoscopic procedures, such as:

- Treatment for Barrett's Esophagus
- Endoscopic Retrograde Cholangiopancreatography (ERCP)
- Endoscopic Ultrasound (EUS)
- Surgical Endoscopy
- Therapeutic Endoscopy

Guthrie offers **Endoscopic Ultrasound (EUS)**, which combines endoscopy and ultrasound to create images of the digestive tract and its surrounding organs and tissues. By using sound waves to create more detailed images of a patient's digestive tract, including the esophagus, stomach, bile ducts, lymph nodes and organs near the digestive tract (pancreas, liver and gallbladder), we can look for causes of abdominal pain, abnormal labs or x-rays, or unusual weight loss, with the goal of leading to a clearer diagnosis. EUS also may help characterize lesions or bumps on the walls of the stomach and intestines.

Options are also available when issues arise in the liver, gallbladder, bile ducts and pancreas, through access to **Endoscopic Retrograde Cholangiopancreatography (ERCP)**. By using ERCP, we can identify and treat the cause of unexplained yellowing of the skin and eyes. ERCP can help locate and diagnose certain conditions, including:

- Bile duct stones
- Damage from pancreatitis
- Various types of cancer



